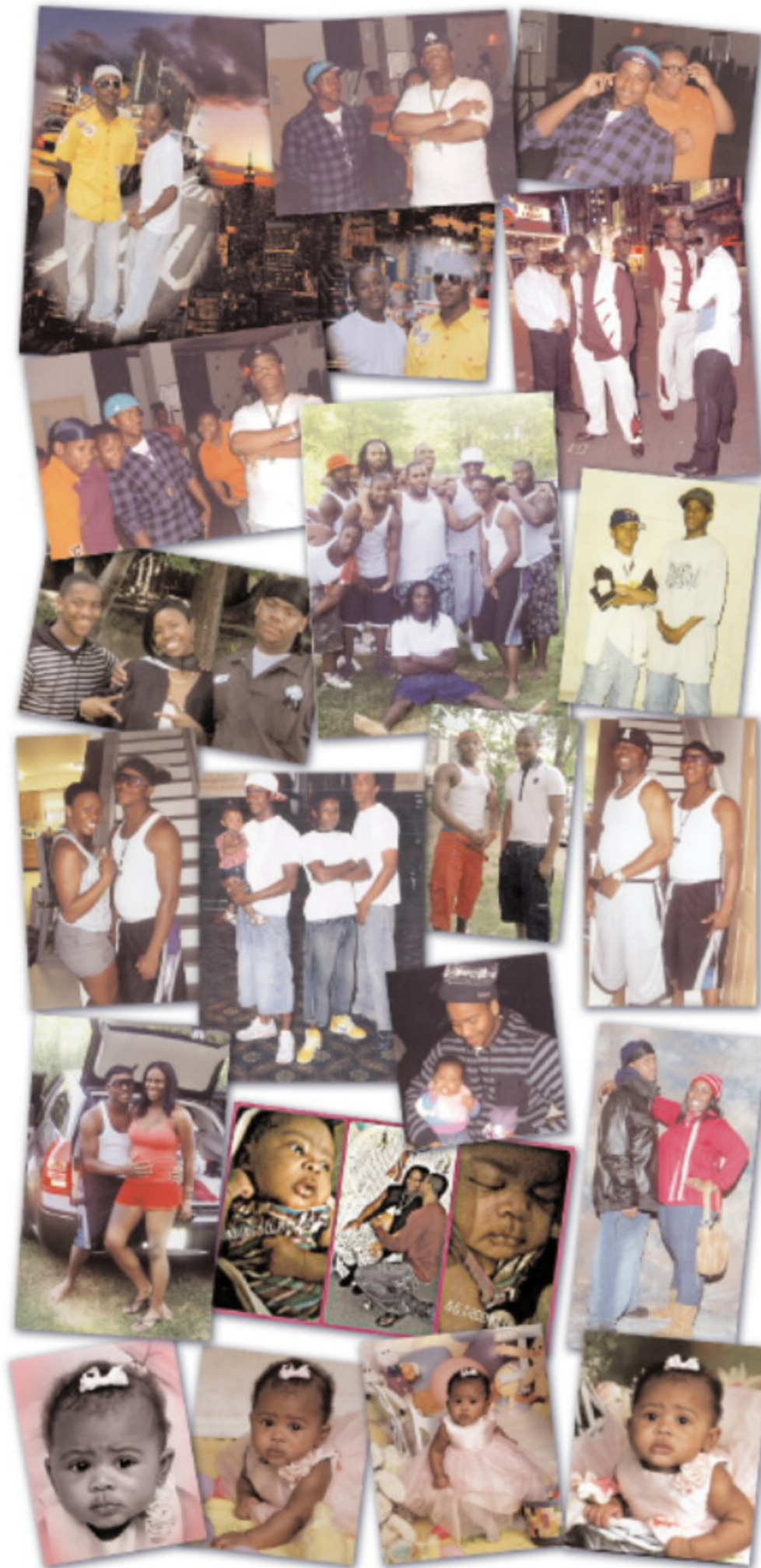
God took with him an astonishing young man. All the qualities that Shawn held could never be captured in words. Shawn Miller's name alone means great things:
